

Little Sleepy Owl "Lilbeth"



You need:

Crochet hook 2.5 mm / US: B / UK: 12, a yarn that match with your crochet hook in the colors: Brown, Grey-Brown, light Grey, Orange;
2 Eyes for making Amigurumi (you will get it in a good sorted Store for crochet and knitting requirement), a wool needle and fiberfill to stuff the Owl

Hint:

When you sew the different parts together, make sure you always sew "inside", don't use the single crochets outside, use those in the second row,
if you do it this way you will be sure that the thread is invisible.

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Shortcuts:

CH = Chain Stitch (i always write how many chain stitches you have to do)

SC = Single Crochet

SL ST = Slip Stitch

hdc = half double crochet

inc. = increase

dec. = decrease

FO = fasten off

Begin with the round part of the eyes, (use light grey yarn), 2x:



Magic circle 6 sc, close with sl st, crochet 1 ch

1. round inc. around, close with sl st = 12 sc, close with sl st, leave a long yard-thread for sewing

Head, (use brown yarn) 1x:



Magic circle 6 sc, close with sl st, crochet 1 ch

1. round inc. around, close with sl st = 12 sc, crochet 1 ch

2. round inc every 2. sc, close with sl st = 18 sc, crochet 1 ch

3. round inc every 3. sc, close with sl st = 24 sc, crochet 1 ch

4. round inc every 4. sc, close with sl st = 30 sc, crochet 1 ch

5. round crochet sc, (no more inc.) close with sl st = 30 sc, crochet 1 ch

6. - 12. rounds crochet like round 5

13. round 3 sc, every 4. + 5. sc crochet "together" (dec.) repeat that till the end of the round, close with sl st = 24 sc, crochet 1 ch

14. round 2 sc, every 3. + 4. sc crochet "together" (dec.) repeat that till the end of the round, close with sl st = 18 sc, crochet 1 ch

Place now the eyes on the front of the Head and stuff the head firmly with fiberfill

15. round 1 sc, every 2. + 3. sc crochet "together" (dec.) repeat that till the end of the round, close with sl st = 12 sc, crochet 1 ch

16. round every 1. + 2. sc crochet "together" (dec.) repeat that till the end of the round, close with sl st = 6 st, leave a long yard-thread for sewing

FO

Lower Eyelids (use grey-brown yarn) 2x:



crochet 4 ch + 1 ch for turn at the end of the row

1. row crochet sc = 4 sc, leave a long yarn-thread for sewing

FO

Upper Eyelids (use grey-brown yarn) 2x:



crochet 6 ch + 1 ch for turn at the end of the row

1. row crochet sc = 6 sc, crochet 1 ch

2. row crochet 1 sc, 2. + 3. sc crochet "together" (dec.), 4. + 5. sc crochet together (dec.), crochet 1 sc = 4 sc, leave a long yarn-thread for sewing

FO

Ears (use brown yarn and grey-brown yarn for the threads at the end) 2x:



leave a long start-yarn-thread for sewing

Magic circle 6 sc, close with sl st, crochet 1 ch

1. round crochet sc = 6 sc, close with sl st, crochet 1 ch

2. round dec. around (always 1. + 2. sc crochet "together"), close with sl st = 3 sc, FO

- 3 threads of grey-brown yarn (ca. 4 cm) thread through the stitches on the top of the ear, tie the ends of them together and fray them so that they look like them on the picture.

sew the ears with the start-yarn-thread on the top of the head.

Beak (use orange yarn) 1x:



crochet 2 ch + 1 ch for turn at the end of the row

1. row crochet sc = 2 sc , crochet 1 ch

2. row inc. every sc = 4 sc, leave a long yarn-thread for sewing, FO

Nightcap (use orange yarn) 1x:



Make sure you have a long yarn-thread at the beginning (i call it "start-yarn-thread"), you will need it later

Magic circle 6 sc, close with sl sc, crochet 1 ch

1. round inc. around, close with sl st = 12 sc, crochet 1 ch

2. round inc. every 2. sc, close with sl st = 18 sc, crochet 1 ch

3. round crochet sc, (no more inc.) close with sl st = 18 sc, crochet 1 ch

4. + 5. rounds crochet like round 3, at the end of round 5 don't crochet 1 ch, leave a long yard-thread for sewing, FO

Pull the start-thread through the little hole of the magic circle. With this start-yarn-thread crochet 1 ch tight at the upper ending of the nightcap (at the magic circle).

Crochet 4 sc in the stitches of the magic circle, close with sl st, crochet 6 ch, FO

- 3 threads of the orange yarn (ca. 4 cm) thread through the last ch, tie the ends of them together and fray them so that they look like them on the picture.

Body (use brown yarn) 1x:



Magic circle 6sc, close with sl st, crochet 1 ch

1. round in. around, close with sl st = 12 sc, crochet 1 ch

2. round inc. every 2. sc, close with sl st = 18 sc, crochet 1 ch

3. round inc. every 3. sc, close with sl st = 24 sc, crochet 1 ch

4. round inc. every 4. sc, close with sl st = 30 sc, crochet 1 ch

5. round inc. every 5. sc, close with sl st = 36 sc, crochet 1 ch

6. round inc. every 6. sc, close with sl st = 42 sc, crochet 1 ch

7. round crochet sc, (no more inc.) close with sl st = 42 sc, crochet 1 ch

8. - 17. rounds crochet like round 7

18. round 5 sc, every 6. + 7. sc crochet "together" (dec.) repeat that till the end of the round, close with sl st = 36 sc, crochet 1 ch

19. round 4 sc, every 5. + 6. sc crochet "together" (dec.) repeat that till the end of the round, close with sl st = 30 sc, crochet 1 ch

20. round 3 sc, every 4. + 5. sc crochet "together" (dec.) repeat that till the end of the round, close with sl st = 24 sc, crochet 1 ch

Stuff the body firmly with fiberfill

21. round 2 sc, every 3. + 4. sc crochet "together" (dec.) repeat that till the end of the round, close with sl st = 18 sc, crochet 1 ch

22. round 1 sc, every 2. + 3. sc crochet "together" (dec.) repeat that till the end of the round, close with sl st = 12 sc, crochet 1 ch

23. round every 1. + 2. sc crochet "together" (dec.) repeat that till the end of the round, close with sl st = 6 st

FO

Feet (use orange yarn) 2x:



leave a long start-yarn-thread for sewing

crochet 2 ch + 1 ch for turn at the end of the row

1. row crochet sc = 2 sc, crochet 1 ch
2. row inc. every sc = 4 sc, crochet 2 ch (!)
3. row crochet hdc = 4 hdc

Stomach (use grey-brown yarn and for the last round light grey yarn) 1x:



Magic circle 6sc, close with sl sc, crochet 1 ch

1. round in. around, close with sl st = 12 sc, crochet 1 ch

2. round inc. every 2. sc, close with sl st = 18 sc, crochet 1 ch

3. round inc. every 3. sc, close with sl st = 24 sc, crochet 1 ch

4. round inc. every 4. sc, close with sl st = 30 sc, crochet 1 ch

5. round inc. every 5. sc, close with sl st = 36 sc, crochet 1 ch

colorchange to light grey

round inc. every 6. sc, close with sl st = 42 sc, leave a long yard-thread for sewing

Wings (use grey-brown yarn) 2x:



leave a long start-yarn-thread for sewing

crochet 3 ch + 1 ch for turn at the end of the row

1. row crochet sc = 3 sc, crochet 1 ch

2. row inc. every sc = 6 sc, crochet 1 ch

3. row inc. every 2. sc = 9 sc, crochet 1 ch

4. row inc. every 3. sc = 12 sc, crochet 1 ch

5. row every 1. + 2. sc crochet "together" (dec.) repeat that till the end of the row = 6 sc, crochet 1 ch

6. row crochet sc = 6 sc, crochet 1 ch

7. row crochet 1 sc every 2. + 3. sc crochet "together" (dec.), repeat that till the end of the row = 4 sc, crochet 1 ch

8. row crochet sc = 4 sc, crochet 1 ch

9. row crochet sc = 4 sc, crochet 1 ch

10. row very 1. + 2. sc crochet "together" (dec.) repeat that till the end of the row = 2 sc, crochet 1 sc

11. row crochet sc = 2 sc, crochet 1 ch

12. row crochet 1. + 2. sc "together" (dec) = 1 sc

Blanket (use orange yarn) 1x:



crochet 20 ch + 1 ch for turn at the end of the row

1. row crochet sc = 20 sc, crochet 1 ch

2.-19. row crochet like round 1

20. row crochet sc = 20 sc
